

About the Aboriginal Admission Access

The Aboriginal* Admission Access (AAA) is designed to increase the participation of Aboriginal people into the University of South Australia by providing choices to Undergraduate programs.

The AAA is an alternative pathway for students to gain entry to UniSA who do not meet the criteria through the South Australian Tertiary Admissions Centre (SATAC) application process, and who may not have an adequate Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) score.

Completion of the AAA application form does not guarantee acceptance.

Eligibility

The Aboriginal Admission Access is available to Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander applicants only.

Wirringka Student Services supports a fair and equitable admission process, and you must successfully meet all the necessary requirements to enter the Aboriginal Admissions Access with the University of South Australia.
