- Female students may wear Navy/Black knee length straight skirt (no frills or asymmetric hem lines).
- Shoes - black or navy closed (no sports shoes/sneakers; minimum heel height).
- Socks - plain black or navy.
- A plain navy blue or black, fine knit woolen jumper, cardigan or vest with a v-neck, may be worn to and from clinical placement and during breaks.
- Acceptable jewellery includes: plain band ring, watch, discreet neck chain, plain earrings (ie studs/sleepers) and medic-alert bracelet. All other jewellery is not permitted.
- Hair – off the face and if longer than collar length neatly tied back.
- Protective clothing may be worn at the discretion of the Clinical Supervisor.
- The University of South Australia identification name badge must be prominently displayed at all times.
- A LUXEL monitor must be worn at all times.

Please note:

- If a student does not comply with the stated Uniform Policy, the Clinical Supervisor may require them to leave the clinical site until they do comply.
- Please consult your clinical coordinator if you wish to vary this uniform policy due to personal or cultural reasons

Wearing of Artificial Fingernails / Nail Enhancements

Recent studies have demonstrated that health care workers with artificial nails are more likely to harbour pathogens which may be transmitted to patients and result in infection. As a response to these studies and information provided by the Infection Control Committee at the RAH, the UniSA Allied Health and Human Performance Medical Radiation Program has adopted a policy whereby the wearing of artificial nails or nail enhancements is no longer permitted by UniSA Bachelor of Medical Radiation students.

Artificial nails or nail enhancements include but are not limited to the following:

Artificial nails, Nail jewellery applied to the nail surface or pierced through the nail, Appliqués, Tips, Wraps, Gels or Acrylics

Fingernails should be kept trimmed, clean and neatly manicured. Nails should be free from nail polish. Any student currently wearing artificial nails must have these professionally removed or grow the artificial nails out.
